SIAM UKIE ACTIVITIES REPORT 2016–2017

Background

The SIAM UKIE Section was formed in 1996 by the Society of Industrial and Applied Mathematics (SIAM) with the scope to promote and support applied and industrial mathematics in the UK and the Republic of Ireland.

Officers

The current SIAM UKIE officers are

Members

Membership of the Section is free and automatic for all SIAM members whose residence or principal place of work or study is in the UK or Republic of Ireland.

Students

There are currently 12 SIAM UKIE Student Chapters at the following universities: University of Bath (England), University of Cambridge (England), Cardiff University (Wales), Heriot-Watt/Edinburgh Universities (Scotland), National University of Ireland Galway (Ireland), Imperial College London (England), University of Limerick (Ireland), University of Manchester (England), University of Oxford (England), University of Strathclyde (Scotland), University of Warwick (England).

The new Student Chapter at the University of Limerick has been founded in 2016 and held its inaugural conference in December 2016.

The Section promotes and supports the founding of further Student Chapters. Most recently, members at the University of Nottingham and the University of Leeds have signaled interest in founding a chapter and they are now collecting the required signatures.

All SIAM UKIE Student Chapters are very active, organizing their own local events and activities. Some examples taken from the recently created SIAM UKIE blog are listed below, with clickable links in the electronic PDF version of this document:

- The "Full STEAM Ahead" and "Three Minute Thesis" events organized by the Cardiff SIAM-IMA Student Chapter (see link 1 and link 2, respectively).
- The "AutoTrader Problem Solving Event" by the Manchester SIAM-IMA Chapter (link).
- The "Careers Evening" organized by the Chapter at NUI Galway (link).

In addition to these activities, one of the chapters hosts an annual SIAM National Student Chapter Conference (SNSCC) since 2012. These conferences allow students to interact across universities. The 6th SNSCC was organized by the Student Chapter at NUI Galway. It was held on May 26, 2017 as the first first SNSCC meeting to take place in Ireland. This account currently has 164 followers (up from 99 last year) and is mainly used to draw attention to new blog posts and for retweeting UKIE relevant news.

Newsletter

The SIAM UKIE Section continues to send newsletters compiled from the most recent posts on the SIAM UKIE blog. These newsletters successfully serve the purpose of "staying in touch" with our members and to further facilitate the dissemination of information among members from different areas in the UK and the Republic of Ireland.

Annual Sectional Meeting

The 21st Anniversary Meeting of the UK and Republic of Ireland Section of SIAM was held on January 12, 2017 at the Department of Mathematics and Statistics of the University of Strathclyde. The local organizer was Prof. Des Higham. The event featured high-profile keynote and early career speakers, and poster presentations. For the first time, travel awards have been given out on merit (and not automatically to all student chapter representatives) and dependent on the distance of travel.
